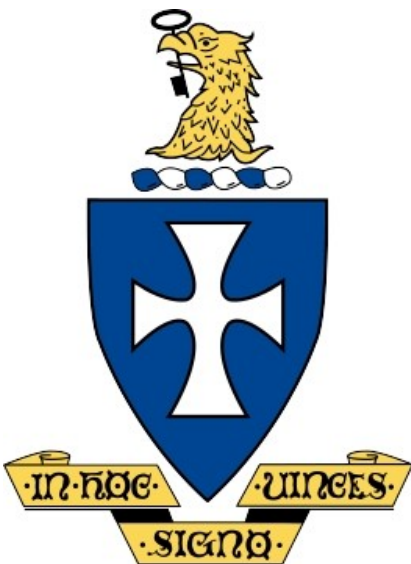
House Improvements

Throughout the course of the summer the Brothers living in the house did a number of clean-up and improvement projects to the Chapter House. Clean-up projects included throwing away old furniture and out dated items from the North Side rooms, library, boiler room and caves. The backyard was also scrapped of old junk and unused items.
